BID NOTICE UNDER OPEN DOMESTIC BIDDING

1. Kampala Capital City Authority shall receive funds from the Government of the Republic of Uganda to be used for the acquisition of;

Construction Completion of the Selected Drainage Systems in Kampala City- [(a)St. Denis (610m),Kabaluka (202m), and Nakinyuguzi (498m) in Makindye Division;; and (b) Nabunya (386m), Kimera (210m), & Kabawoo(200m) and Sebanja (185m) in Lubaga Division]

- The above works will also include and are NOT limited to: all associated external works including earth works, gabion lining, site clearance, installation of foot/ pedestrian/carriageway bridges and guard rails, construction of tributary channels up to 20m and landscaping.
- 3. The Entity invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the provision of the above works.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open domestic bidding method contained in the Government of Uganda's Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2003 (Amended March 2014) and is open to all bidders.
- 5. To qualify for award, the Bidder must meet the following minimum qualifying requirements:
 - General Construction experience of not less than five years as contractor with work of similar projects and the bidder should clearly show this by attaching copies of ongoing contracts and completion certificates for the completed Projects
 - Minimum average annual construction turnover of not less than Uganda Shillings Ten Billion (UGX)

- 10,000,000,000) equivalent over the last five years.
- Experience as contractor in at least 3 (three) similar drainage/roads/buildings contracts within the last 3 (three) years, with a value of at least UGX billion (10,000,000,000), and have been successfully completed, OR as indicated in the evaluation criteria
- Experience in implementing drainage development projects. In the event that the firm does not have internal capacity to undertake construction works, they will be required to associate, in joint arrangement (Joint Ventures), with a contractor of sufficient capacity to undertake the construction works. The contractor in the association shall not be part of any other bidder participating in the bidding process and a statement of exclusivity and availability throughout the contract duration shall be submitted as part of the tender. Additionally, a MoU/contract between the main contract and MUST be included in the proposal.
- The bidder should clearly show capacity to access a cash flow amount of Uganda Shillings: One Billion shillings (UGX 1,000,000,000/=) or equivalent.
- 6. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below at 10(a) from 9:00am to 5:00pm.
- 7. The Bidding documents (digital copy for all volumes, hard copy for the drawings, all in **English**) may be purchased by interested bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below at 8(b) and upon payment of a non-refundable tender fee of **UGX 500,000** (Uganda Shillings, five hundred thousand only) to KCCA. Bidders will only be issued Bidding Documents upon presentation of an original receipt of payment. The documents shall be physically collected from the address in 10(a) below. The method of payment will be by Bank Payment Advice Form issued by the Employer. The bidding documents may be collected by the bidder from the address in 10(b) below.
- 8. There shall be a pre-bid meeting/site visit on Wednesday 6th March 2019 on the dates indicated in the proposed schedule in this notice.
- 9. Bids must be delivered and registered to the address in No.10 (c) at or before 11:00AM, on ...26th March 2019. All bids must be accompanied with a bid security of UGX 80,000,000 (Eighty Million Uganda Shillings only) in form of a Bank Guarantee from any recognized commercial bank in Uganda. Bid securities must be valid until 148 days after bid submission date. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below in No 10(b) at time ...11:30am on 26th March 2019.
