Notes to the financial statements

1. GENERALINFORMATION

Kampala Capital City Authority was established by the Kampala Capital City Act of Parliament in 2010. The Authority is the governing body of the Capital City and administers the Capital City on behalf of the Central Government

The principal address of the entity is: Kampala Capital City Authority, P.O Box 7010 Kampala (U) Website:www.kcca.go.ug

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented, unless otherwise stated.

a) Reporting period

The reporting period for these financial statements is according to Kampala Capital City Authority accounting period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2016. It is also worth noting that it is aligned with Government of Uganda financial year.

b) Basis of accounting

The Accounts are prepared on historical cost basis of accounting. Revenue Collections and expenditures are accounted for on accruals basis.

c) Basis of preparation

These financial statements have been prepared on a going -concern basis and the accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the period

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Public Finance Management Act, 2015, International Public Sector Accounting principles and comply with generally accepted accounting principles taking into consideration the Government of Uganda legal and regulatory framework regarding public finances.

d) Functional currency and translation of foreign currencies

(i) Presentation currency

The Reporting & presentation currency is the Uganda Shilling, which is the legal tender of the Republic of Uganda. Items included in the financial statements are measured in the currency of the primary economic environment in which the entity operates.

(ii) Translation of transactions in foreign currency

Foreign currency transactions are translated into Uganda shillings using the exchange rates prevailing at the dates of the transactions. Foreign exchange gains and losses resulting from the settlement of such transactions and from the translation at year-end exchange rates of monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are recognized in the statement of financial performance.

e) Revenue

Revenue represents gross inflows into the entity during the financial year and comprises Transfers from the Consolidated Fund, Grants received, Tax and Non-Tax Revenues.

Subject to Article 152 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda, tax is levied with the authority of Parliament.

Many services and benefits are provided by the accounting entity to the public but these do not necessarily give rise to revenue to the entity. Equivalently, payment of tax and other dues do not necessarily result into an entitlement to the taxpayer to receive equivalent value of services or benefits because there is no explicit relationship between payments of tax and other dues, and receipt of goods and services from the Government. Revenue is recognized as follows:

(i) Transfers from the Consolidated Fund

Transfers from the Consolidated Fund to the entity are recognized when transfer is made. Transfers are made periodically to facilitate the operations of the entity in accordance with the appropriated budget and the cash limits that have been established for Government spending for the period.

(ii) Grants

Grants are recognized when received. Similarly, grants/transfers to other entities of Government are recognized (expensed) when disbursement is made.

(iii) Revenue

Revenue includes gross inflows from sales of designated and non-designated services by the entity. Sales of services are recognized in the period when the service is rendered or when the income falls due.

Interest income is recognized within the statement of financial performance on the accrual basis.

(iv) Provision for bad debts.

Specific provision is made where there is certainty of non-recovery of particular receivable of entire amount on the ledger. In addition to specific provisions, Kampala Capital City Authority maintains a general provision of 10% of the total outstanding Receivables at each reporting period.

Annual Financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2016 The provisioning level is reviewed at least on annual basis whenever necessary.

f) Expenses

In general, expenditure is recognized when incurred. Expenses relating to pension liabilities, domestic arrears and interest expense on treasury bills and bonds are accrued for in the financial statements.

g) Non-Current Assets

(i) Plant and Equipment

All Plant and equipment are stated at historical cost. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items. All other repairs and maintenance costs are charged to the statement of financial performance.

(ii) Land and Building

Land and Building are essentially separable assets.

(iii) Motor vehicle and Motor cycle

Motor Vehicle and Motor cycle are stated at either historical cost. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the asset.

On establishment of KCCA, assets whose value could not be ascertained were put to valuation by the Chief government valuer in order to establish the value.

h) Depreciation and amortization

Depreciation has been computed to write off the cost or value of assets, other than land and properties under construction and or renovation, over their estimated useful economic lives using the straight-line method. For consistency purposes the previous policy has been applied as follows;

The depreciation charged has been appropriated on the effective date of use.

Intangible assets are initially measured at cost and subsequently amortized on a systematic basis over their useful life. Intangible assets with indefinite life are not amortized but reviewed for impairment annually.

i) Provisions-expenses

Provisions are recognized when the Organization has a legal or constructive obligation as a result of a past event, and where it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, and where a reliable estimate of the amount of the obligation can be made.

j) Budget

The original budget was approved. The budget objectives and policies and subsequent revisions are explained fully in the Operational Review and Out-turn Report issued in conjunction with the financial statements. In budget accounting, capital expenditures are recorded as current year expenses while in accrual accounting this expense is capitalized and depreciated over the estimate useful economic lives of the assets.

k) Receivables

(i) Advances and other receivables

Receivables are carried at original historical cost. Bad debts when identified are written –off as per procedure outlined in the Financial regulations 2015. These are reflected in the Statement of Financial Performance.

(ii) Letters of credit

Procurement of goods and services through letters of credit which are cash covered are recognized in the statement of appropriation when the letter of credit is opened. Outstanding letters of credit at period-end are treated as deposits receivable and expensed in the following period when the goods and services are delivered.

l) Inventories

Stocks are stated at cost using FIFO method of stock valuation. Cost comprises of purchase price plus any other expenses incurred to make the stock ready for its intended use. Obsolete stocks are value at cost and not net realizable value since this stock are not held for sale.

m) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents are carried in the Statement of Financial Position (SOFP) at cost. For the purposes of the cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand, and bank overdrafts. In the Statement of Financial Position, bank overdrafts are included in borrowings.

Unspent cash balances (Government Grants)

In accordance with the requirement of the Public Finance Management Act 2015, unspent cash balances at the end of the financial year are due to the Consolidated Fund.

Transfers of unspent cash balances (government grants) for the period under review to the Consolidated Fund are treated in the statement of financial performance as transfers to Treasury.

n) Borrowings

Borrowings are initially recorded in the Statement of Financial Position at cost net of any transaction costs paid.

Interest expense or income on borrowings is recognized in the Statement of Financial Performance when due.

o) Employee benefits

Employee benefits include salaries, allowances, pensions and other related-employment costs. Employee benefits are recognized when incurred. No provision is made for accrued leave or reimbursable duty allowances.

p) Contingencies

Contingent liabilities are recorded in the Statement of Contingencies Liabilities when the contingency becomes evident. Contingent assets are neither recognized nor disclosed.

q) Commitments

Commitments include operating and capital commitments arising from non-cancellable contractual or statutory obligations. Interest commitments on loans and commitments relating to employment contracts are not included in the Statement of Outstanding Commitments. Outstanding commitments are included in the Statement of Financial Position as payables and in the Statement of Outstanding Commitments.

r) Subsequent events

There were no post reporting date events that required amendment or disclosure in the financial statement as at the date of this report.

s) Payables and accrued

Payables and accrued expenses are recognized at fair value

t) Exchange rates

All monetary amounts in the financial statements are expressed in Uganda Shillings, the legal tender. The Uganda Shilling closing rates (the Bank of Uganda middle rate) for United States Dollar was UGX. 3,409.86.

In addition to specific provisions, Kampala Capital City Authority maintains a general provision of 10% of the total outstanding Receivables and this provisioning level is reviewed at least on annual basis.

During the year, the Minister of Finance, planning and economic development authorised a write off of property rates and ground rates arrears on government buildings and properties.

15. BORROWINGS

This was a development credit agreement between IDA and KCC on behalf of Government of Uganda, entered into on 12th August 1991, for improvement of waste management in the city, production of up to date maps of Kampala area and strengthening the financial and personnel management systems and services.

Since then no servicing of the loan has been made and it remained on KCC books as an outstanding obligation pending servicing and clearance. Currently KCCA has no capacity to service this Loan and Management wrote to Ministry of finance seeking authorization to have the debt written off. The permanent secretary Ministry of Finance planning and Economic Development advised that we maintain the loan on our books until parliament authorizes the write off.

This project ended on 30th June 2000 and the Uganda shillings equivalent as inherited from KCC is summarized below;
