Assignment Title: CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR DESIGN OF A TRAFFIC CONTROL CENTRE BUILDING.

Kampala Capital City Authority (KCCA) received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Second Kampala Institutional and Infrastructure Development Project (KIIDP2), and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards Consultancy Services for the Design of a Traffic Control Centre (TCC) Building.

The new building that will be a multistoried building constructed at City Hall i.e. KCCA's headquarters at Plot 1-3, Apollo Kaggwa Road, Kampala, and will accommodate a traffic control centre, offices and underground car parking. It shall be linked to the existing building to facilitate efficient people movement between the old and new buildings. The TCC Building will have high level security measures such as employee access control, public access control and fire security systems and these are to be included in the design. The TCC data centre shall be planned to accommodate amongst others server cabinets, back-up systems, false floors, filtered air and UPS's.

The assignment will be carried out over a period of eight (08) calendar months.

KCCA now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria will be as follows:

1) General experience of the firm in at least fifteen (15) assignments in infrastructure engineering studies, design and construction supervision;

- 2) Relevant experience of the firm in at least ten (10) assignments of similar nature and scope as the TCC Building design assignment;
- 3) Availability of appropriate skills/expertise among the consultant's staff including Project Manager, Architects, Structural Engineers, Electrical Engineers, Civil Engineers, Mechanical Engineers, Quantity Surveyors, Environmental Specialists, Fire Design Engineers. The key professionals to be engaged on the project shall be registered with relevant professional bodies.

Individual experts' bio-data is not required.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers January 2011* ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consulting firms may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. The type of association whether a joint venture or a sub-consultancy, where applicable, must be clearly indicated in the Expression of Interest.
