ROUTINE MAINTANANCE OF BUILDING PREMISES, FRONTAGES, WALKWAYS AND GENERAL CLEANLINESS IN THE CITY

Kampala City will host the Pope in November 2015.

Kampala Capital City Authority reminds all property owners, tenants and the general public to ensure that buildings are kept clean, painted and the adjacent spaces maintained.

The following should be duly addressed:

- Painting of buildings with permissible color schemes.
- 2. Fixing all broken sanitary and waste management facilities within and around the buildings.
- 3. Paving all open spaces within and around the building using prefabricated concrete slates measuring 4500x4500mm.
- 4. Planting of grass and flowers on all open earth spaces within and around individual

- residential plots to prevent soil erosion and dust.
- Removing all unauthorized roadside and road reserve parking and re-greening the affected sections.
- 6. Maintaining the green spaces from over growth and bushes.
- Removal of all unauthorized vending /roadside businesses including dealerships in coffins, furniture, fabricated metal works, garages and washing bays, used car scraps in the road reserves, among others.
- 8. Removal of all illegal/unauthorized markets, bars, night clubs, health clubs, kiosks, temporary structures, clinics, drug-shops, places of worship and all associated nuisances, especially in residential areas.
- Removal of all unauthorized hoardings around buildings, incomplete structures and

- abandoned sites or hoardings for which erection permits have expired.
- 10. Placement of garbage bins at commercial premises.
- 11. Proper disposal of solid waste and collection of garbage from private residences and commercial premises by authorized garbage and solid waste collectors.

KCCA shall inspect premises and their surroundings for compliance and whoever does not comply risk their premises being closed, demolished or prosecuted in accordance with the relevant laws.
