



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (CONSULTING SERVICES – FIRMS SELECTION)

Assignment Title: PROVISION OF ENGINEERING CONSULTANCY SERVICES ON FRAMEWORK BASIS FOR PERIOD FY 2016/2017 and FY 2017/2018

The **Kampala Capital City Authority** has received funding from the Government of Uganda intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for engineering design of different types of city physical infrastructure, supervision of infrastructure construction, engineering studies and engineering assessments for various upcoming projects.

Some of the selected consulting services (“the Services”) include;

The provision of construction supervision services for;

- (1) Reconstruction and or upgrading of Namirembe-Luwuum – 1.5km, Nakivubo Channel - 0.5km, Mpabaana-0.75km, Luzigen – 0.3km, Mutebi – 0.45km and Semugooma 0.4km in Central Division
- (2) Reconstruction and or upgrading of Jakaana – 0.65km, Nsooba – 0.75km, Kafeero – 0.8km, Lumasi -0.55km, Muganzi-Awongera – 1.6km and Waligo – 4.2km in Kawempe Division and Bakuli market lane 1.0km, Nakibinge- Bawalakata 2.9km, Mackay – 1.6km and Sembera-1.5km, Concrete Box Culvert at Sembule and Nalukolongo Channel in Lubaga Division
- (3) Reconstruction and/or upgrading of Kulekana-2.1km, Nsambya-Katwe-0.95km, Jjuko-1.3km, Kevina-1.2km, Appas-1.3km and Bugolobi-Namuwongo Link-0.4km in Makindye Division
- (4) Reconstruction and/or upgrading of Magambo-0.9km, Dembe-Kilowoza-3.0km, Kiziri-0.75km, Kigoowa-1.9km, Kimera-1.4km, Kisalita-0.7km, Kisosonkole-1.0km, and Robert Mugabe-1.8km in Nakawa division
- (5) Extended periodic maintenance of Kalungu road-2.5km and Nantongo road-0.55km in Makindye Division
- (6) Extended periodic maintenance of RX2 road-0.5km in Lubaga Division, and Kayinda road-0.55km and NWSC road 0.65km in Nakawa Division

Drainage Supervision Works;

- (1) Design Update and Construction of Selected Drainage Systems 2015-17. Design Update and Construction of Selected Drainage Systems in Kampala City (Central, Nakawa, Lubaga and Makindye Divisions)

- (2) Design Update and Construction of Selected Drainage Systems 2016-18; Design Update and Construction of Selected Drainage Systems in Kampala City (Central, Nakawa, Lubaga, Makindye and Kawempe Divisions)

The services shall not only cover these projects but others too that shall come as need arises. The assignment will be carried out over two financial years i.e. FY2016/2017, and F2017/2018.

The **Kampala Capital City Authority** now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating their eligibility and that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria are:

a) The eligibility of a consultant

- i. Full names of the consultant, address and registration details/certificates
- ii. Authorized contact person (s)
- iii. A brief profile of the consultant
- iv. The consultant has the legal capacity to enter into a contract with the procuring and disposing entity;
- v. The consultant is not insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up;
- vi. The business activities of the consultant are not suspended;
- vii. The consultant is not the subject of legal proceedings for any of the circumstances
- viii. The consultant fulfilled the obligations to pay taxes and social security contributions in Uganda;
- ix. The consultant does not have a conflict of interest in relation to the subject of the procurement;
- x. the consultant is not suspended by the Authority

b) Qualifications and relevant experience

- i. General experience of the firm in at least ten (10) assignments of which two (2) are for engineering studies, four (4) are for design and four (4) are for construction supervision;
- ii. Relevant experience of the firm on at least 3 assignments of road infrastructure design where the value of services offered on each assignment is at least UGX 100m;
- iii. Relevant experience of the firm on at least 4 assignments of road infrastructure construction supervision where the value of services offered on each assignment is at least UGX 250m;
- iv. Relevant experience of the firm on at least 2 assignments of urban drainage infrastructure design where the value of services offered on each assignment is at least UGX 200m;
- v. Relevant experience of the firm on at least 4 assignments of urban drainage infrastructure construction supervision where the value of civil works executed offered on each assignment is atleast UGX 800m;
- vi. Availability of appropriate experts among the consultant’s staff including

- a) Highway/Pavement engineer,
- b) Transport and traffic Planning engineer,
- c) Materials engineer,
- d) Structural engineer,
- e) Engineering surveyor,
- f) Measurement engineer,
- g) Urban traffic control engineer
- h) Social and environmental experts.
- i) Hydraulic Engineer
- j) Transport Economist
- k) Property Valuer

All the key professional staff to be provided by the Consultant must be chartered or registered professional Engineers with a relevant degree qualification.

Consultants **shall not** associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications

The eligibility of a consultant shall be evaluated on a pass or fail basis method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.

After shortlisting, RFPs will be issued to successful consultants. At RFP stage, the required services shall be lotted into four different lots.
