Un-demolished Structures along Bakuli-Nankulabye-Kasubi Road

PREMISE

- Safety is paramount for a successful road project.
- Building regulations are still relevant and prevail even during road construction.

THE ISSUE

- 1. All fully compensated buildings are supposed to be entirely demolished. However, partially demolished buildings are still standing along this road.
- 2. People are living in partially demolished and weak buildings which poses a big danger to their lives should the structures collapse.
- 3. Some owners are remodeling their buildings without approved plans. This undermines both the potential value of the property and overall facelift of the neighborhood.

THE OPPORTUNITY FOR AFFECTED PROPERTY OWRNERS

- 1. The project has fully compensated the owners of affected buildings along this road.
- 2. Compensation is to enable property owners to replace their affected properties in a safer and improved manner. However, already compensated buildings will not be re-assessed.
- 3. The improved road will enhance the value of property and ensure safety of residents with street lighting as well as pedestrian walkways.

A CALL TO ACTION BY PROPERTY OWNERS

- 1. Vacate all fully compensated buildings immediately to allow the contractor to continue with road construction.
- 2. Demolish all fully compensated buildings.
- 3. No remodeling or reconstruction is permitted on fully compensated buildings.
- 4. Apply and get KCCA approval before making any new developments on the land owned by the Project-Affected Person adjacent to the road under construction.

PROPOSED ACTION BY KCCA

- 1. Each property was assessed to determine the best course of action and the owner engaged.
- 2. KCCA will enforce and ensure that all current and remodeled buildings meet physical planning specifications after engaging the owners.
- 3. Demolish all fully compensated buildings immediately.
